Explain why a re-evaluation is needed?

A re-evaluation is being conducted due to the addition of work outside of the existing roadway right of way within Strawberry Acres Park to remove the existing sidewalk and relocate the existing fence. Approximately 0.09 acres of property within Strawberry Acres will be temporarily occupied for the removal of the existing walk and removal of existing fence in preparation for the new multi-use path. A Determination Request Form was submitted on 11/13/2023 and an OES determination of Temporary No-Use was received on 11/16/2023. No other changes to the project will occur and all previous coordination and environmental commitments remain valid.

Project Description:

The Village of Holland is currently proposing to resurface McCord Rd from Kipling Dr to Angola Rd due to poor pavement conditions. Additional work includes pot full-depth repairs, curb replacements, replacement of 4' wide sidewalk with 6' wide asphalt path at Strawberry Acres Park, pavement markings, and other necessary related scope items. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to utilities. This project does not include impacts to any waterways or floodplains, therefore no US Army Corps of Engineers or floodplain permits are required. There will be no impacts to any ecological or historically significant resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2024 and last approximately 60 days. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.

- 1) Access to Strawberry Acres Park shall be maintained at all times, except for the time needed to temporarily occupy the property, which shall be less than the time needed for construction of the project.
- 2) Temporary construction fencing shall be installed along proposed construction limits prior to the start of construction activities to protect the Section 4(f) property and the public.
- 3) Appropriate signage shall be installed to alert users of Strawberry Acres Park of construction activities, access restrictions or closures, and to direct users to secondary access points.
- 4) The contractor shall be required to closely coordinate the construction schedule with ODOT and the Village of Holland prior to the start of construction activities.
