**Explain why a re-evaluation is needed?**

The Village of Swanton added 2 small areas of pavement repairs approximately 1000 feet south of the previously approved project limits. All updated mapping has been added to the project file. No additional cultural or ecological impacts from the addition of the pavement repairs were noted. The project still does not require any floodplain or waterway permits. The existing CE is still valid, and all commitments are also still valid.

**Project Description:**

The Village of Swanton is currently proposing to resurface a portion of Hallett Avenue in Lucas County due to poor pavement conditions. Additional work includes spot full-depth pavement repairs, replacement of curb and gutter, and new ADA compliant walk, curb ramps, and crosswalks along the west side of the roadway. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to utilities. This project does not include impacts to any waterways or floodplains, therefore no US Army Corps of Engineers or floodplain permits are required. There will be no impacts to any ecological or historically significant resources. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2026 and last approximately 60 days. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.

This document was approved based on Stage 2 Plans.
