Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is currently proposing to improve the sight distance along US-20 in Pioneer by raising the road on the east side of the bridge near Lake Shore Drive in Williams County OH. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to utilities. No work will occur in any streams or wetlands so no permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers is required. This project is located within a special flood hazard area but the district hydraulic engineer has determined that there will be no impacts to the floodplain (project file). There will be no impacts to any ecological resources and there is minimal potential to cause effects to any historical resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2019 and last approximately 14 days, during which US-20 will be closed. During the closure, a detour route will be posted. There are no residences within the project area that will be directly impacted by the closure, however the public safety and emergency services were still notified of this closure. A press release with the final closure date and detour will be posted closer to the start of construction.

Under no circumstances shall the contractor work in or store equipment and/or materials in any wetlands, streams, or other waters. No work or staging is permitted below the top of bank of any stream and/or within a wetland.
