Project Description:

This project involves fixing broken welds and bolts on a metal plate over an expansion joint on the Interstate 75 (I-75) bridge over the Maumee River due to deterioration and facility deficiency. All work will be done inside the bridge and on top of the deck through an emergency work order. All work is within the existing right of way, no excavation 6 feet or deeper, and there will be no impacts to utilities. The Maumee River is a Section 9 and Section 10 waterway. Coordination with the US Army Corps of Engineers and Coast Guard is on going. This location is also located within a flood hazard area, however there will be no impacts to the floodplain (documentation in project file). There will be no impacts to any ecological or historical resources. This project is north of the section of the Maumee River that is Scenic and Recreational. One lane of traffic on I-75 shall be maintained at all times during construction. There will be no major impacts to traffic. Construction is expected to start the week of August 1, 2018.
