Project Description:

In collaboration with the city of Conneaut in Ashtabula County, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to extinguish 39 feet of limited access (LA) right-of-way along the east side of State Route (SR) 7 approximately 765 feet south of the Interstate Route 90/SR 7 eastbound ramp intersections to establish a new access driveway to the property of a future Truck World truck stop in Conneaut. This action will be accomplished within the existing roadway right-of-way and does not involve any land transfer. Construction activities are also recommended within the existing SR 7 LA right-of-way to install a 12-foot wide, 350-foot long southbound left turn lane, partial section of two (2) 13-foot access driveway egress lanes, partial section of one (1) 13-foot access driveway ingress lane and a new traffic signal for the future Truck World truck stop development. However, all of the recommended construction activities within the existing SR 7 LA right-of-way will be performed by the future Truck World truck stop contractor.

In consideration of the proposed LA right-of-way extinguishment, the action has minimal potential to cause effects on historic properties. Moreover, the action will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the action study area.

The action does not involve maintenance of traffic measures. Therefore, emergency/public services contact activities are not necessary for this action. Moreover, posting of the proposed improvements to the ODOT District 4 website is not deemed to be necessary.

Existing utilities within the action study area will not be impacted/relocated to complete the action.

The environmental document and associated studies, as applicable, were approved using the schematic plan for the action. A copy of the schematic plan for the action is included in the Project File/General/Project Information subsection as Schematic Plan.pdf.
