Project Description:

The Wood County Engineers Office is proposing to paint new pavement marking on various county roads throughout Wood County. All work is within the existing right of way and no utilities will be impacted. There will be no impacts to any jurisdictional waterways so no permits from the USACE or OEPA are required. Several locations are within a special flood hazard area, however no floodplain permits are required. There will be no impacts to any ecologically sensitive species or their habitats. District environmental staff accessed the SHPO database on 3/26/2019 and in accordance with Appendix A of the Section 106 PA executed Nov. 8, 2017, the project will not impact historic properties or historic districts. Construction is expected to begin in the fall of 2019 and last approximately 45 days. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.

The environmental document and associated studies are being approved using Stage 3 Design. A copy of the plans are included in the project file.
