Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to address safety concerns at the US 20 West Central Avenue and McCord Road intersection in Sylvania Township, Lucas County. Improvements include replacing traffic signals and improve signing. Work also includes sign improvements at the US 20 and Percentum Road intersection. All work is within the existing right of way and impacts to utilities are expected.

This project is located within a special flood hazard area however, there will be no impacts to the floodplain. There are no waterway impacts within the project area so no permits are required from the USACE. There is no suitable habitat for any state or federally listed species within the project area so there will be no impacts to any ecological resources. The work included in this project has minimal potential to cause effects to historical resources. Construction is expected to begin summer of 2021 and last approximately 60 days. During construction, lane closures are anticipated.

The environmental document and associated studies are being approved using Stage 2 Design. A copy of the plans is included in the project file.
