Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing lighting and signage updates to improve safety for the US-20/I-475 interchange. All work is within the existing interchange (no right of way) and there will be no impacts to utilities. The project is not located within a flood zone and there will be no impacts to any waterways, so there are no permits required. There will be no impact to any state/federally listed species or their habitats. There are no historically significant resources in the area. Construction will begin spring 2020 and last approximately 30 days. During construction, lane closure are possible but traffic will be maintained at all times.
