Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing to repair the structure that carries US-6 over SR-108 in Napoleon (Henry County). Work includes heat straightening the beams of the US-6 bridge from SR-108 below. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to utilities. There are no waterways or floodplain in the project area so no permits are required. There will be no impacts to any ecologically significant resources and there is minimal potential to cause effects to any historical resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2020 and last approximately 5 days. During construction, SR-108 will be closed and a detour will be posted. All impacted residents, public safety agencies, and schools were notified of the closure.
