Project Description:

The Put-In-Bay Township Port Authority is proposing to repair the Miller Boat Line Lime-Kiln Terminal on South Bass Island (Ottawa County). All work on the dock will be within the current sheet piling footprint or on Miller Ferry property on mainland. No right of way is required and there will be no utility impacts. Since all work is within the existing sheet piling, there is no impacts to Lake Erie and no waterway permits are required. The dock is located within a special flood hazard area and a floodplain permit has been obtained. Since there are no impacts to Lake Erie or any state or federally listed species, there will be no significant ecological impacts. This project is located within the ODNR coastal management zone. The required shore structure permit has been obtained by the port authority. This project has no potential to cause effects on historical properties. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2020 and last 60 days. During construction, the Miller Ferry will still be operational and the construction schedule will work around high use times.

This document was written and approved based on Stage 3 plans.

1) The Project Designer shall incorporate the following note into the plans: The Ohio Department of Natural Resources authorized the project with shore structure permit 19-OTT-24 and a Coastal Consistency Certification on 12/23/2019. The Put-In-Bay Township Port Authority, Miller Boat Line, Inc., and their contractor shall adhere to all appropriate Shore Structure Permit conditions throughout construction. A copy of the ODNR authorizations are included in the contract documents.

2) The Project Designer shall incorporate the following note into the plans: The Contractor shall not place any temporary or permanent fill in or below the ordinary high water mark of Lake Erie outside the confines of the existing dock during construction of this project, including scaffolding or bracing. If debris enters the waterway outside the confines of the existing dock during construction, the Contractor shall remove the debris immediately utilizing equipment staged above the ordinary high water mark or within the confines of the existing dock.
