**Project Description:**

Reconstruct the Detroit Rd (US-6A)/Sloan Avenue (US-20) intersection for improved pedestrian safety. Work includes: the extension of the Metroparks trail on the south side of the roadway, reducing the pedestrian crosswalk lengths at intersections, providing wider sidewalks on the north side of the roadway, installation of new ADA curb ramps, new curbs, removal of the existing median island, removal and replacement of the existing concrete pavement, milling the existing asphalt surface, base repairs, asphalt resurfacing, striping, traffic signal modifications, street lighting improvements, new watermain, sewer main rehabilitation, and other appurtenances.

No cultural resources are located within the project area according to the SHPO Records Check.

The Rocky River Reservation is located adjacent to the project area, The project will connect to the existing trail by crosswalk striping and will not impact the existing trail or park property. Therefore, no Section 4(f) coordination is required.

All work to be within existing r/w. No deep excavation. No work in streams or wetlands. No tree removal.

Construction Cost Estimate: \$2,535,000 90% federal and 10% state.

Three Stake Holder meetings were held and comments were received and addressed by the City of Lakewood. Records of the meetings are in the Project File/Public Involvement/Project Information. Public Involvement Letter were sent out on 6/1/20 and no comments were received by the city. After completing the public involvement for the proposed project the City of Lakewood has decided to proceed with the preferred design.

The C1 Approval is based on Stage 2 Design. Plans are included in Project File/General/Project Information/Stage 2 Design.pdf.
