Project Description:

This project proposes to improve the Interstate 475 and US 23 interchange ramp bridge carrying westbound Interstate 475 to southbound I-475 (LUC-23-0980R structure, SFN 4801059). The project proposes to fix a crack in the top flange of an interior beam by putting a steel plate on a crack in the beam. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to utilities. There are no jurisdictional water resources in the project area so no USACE permits are required. This project is not located within a special flood hazard area so there will be no impacts to the floodplain. There is no suitable habitat for any state or federally listed species within the project area so there will be no impacts to any ecological resources. There is no deep excavation or regulated materials concerns. There was a milk spill within the project area, but that will not impact the project. The work included in this project has minimal potential to cause effects to historical resources. Construction is expected to begin later winter or spring of 2020 and last approximately 30 days. During construction, a minimum of one traffic lane will be maintained at all times for each of the ramps and mainlines.
