Project Description:

The Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) propose to resurface Harvard Avenue from East 190th Street east to Warrensville Center Road in the City of Warrensville Heights, Cuyahoga County. All work performed will be within the existing right-of-way.

The project is considered Ecologically Exempt under the Ecological MOA (Agreement 193340). See Ecological tab for documentation.

A Regulated Materials Review (RMR) Screening was conducted in April 2021. ODOT District 12 provided concurrence with no further investigations required on April 22, 2021. See project file for documentation.

The project is not located within a regulated floodplain, therefore no coordination is required.

The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project area. No deep excavation is required. No work in streams or wetlands. No tree removal.

The C1 approval is based on Preliminary Engineering.
