Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is partnering with the cities of Akron, Canton, and Youngstown to implement pedestrian safety improvements at various locations (25 in Akron, 69 in Canton, and 24 in Youngstown). The improvements may include curb extensions to shorten crosswalk distances, high visibility pavement markings, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) for pedestrian crossings, ADA curb ramps, pedestrian refuge islands, sidewalk repair, street lighting, and improved signage. All work will be conducted within existing right-of-way and no impacts to known environmental resources (i.e. Cultural Resources, Section 4(f) properties, etc.) is anticipated.
