The Ohio Department of Transportation District 2 is proposing to place a new bridge overlay on the Walbridge Rd bridge over I-280 in Wood County. No temporary or permanent right of way is required and no utilities will be impacted for this project. This project is located within a special flood hazard area and the local floodplain administrator has been notified. There will be no impacts to any waters of the US or any state or federally listed species. No historic properties will be affected by this project. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2022 and last for approximately 45 days. This document was written and approved based on a footprint.
