Project Description:

The City of Toledo is proposing to replace the signals at the intersection of Indiana Ave and Washington Street. The work includes new signal poles, pull boxes, signal heads, conduit, cabinets and video detection. All work is within the right of way and temporary utility impacts are anticipated. There is no work within any waters of the US or special flood hazard areas so no permits are required. There will be no impacts to any state or federally listed species or their habitat and this project has minimal potential to cause affects to any historical resources. Construction is expected to begin the summer of 2021 and last approximately 30 days. During construction, a minimum of 1 lane of traffic will be maintained at all times. This document was written and approved based on Stage 1 plans.
