**Project Description:**

TMACOG in partnership with ODOT District 2 is proposing a project to resurface Holland-Sylvania Road from Perrysburg-Holland Road to Merger Drive in Lucas County. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impact to utilities. There will be no impact to any waters of the US or the state but no USACE permits are required. The project is located within a floodplain and but the local floodplain admin determined that a permit was not required. There are some ecological species located within the project area but there will be no impact to any federally or state listed species or their habitat. There are no records of historic resources within the project area so there will be a minimal potential to cause effects. Construction is expected to begin summer of 2022 and last for approximately 45 days.
