Project Description:

Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is proposing to improve pedestrian safety at seven intersections along Euclid Avenue (US-20) in Cuyahoga County. The intersections with Euclid Ave (US-20) include Roxbury Avenue, Superior Avenue (US-6), Lee Boulevard, Rosemont Road, Windermere Street, Belmore Road, and Collamer Avenue in the City of East Cleveland in Cuyahoga County. This project involves installing overhead pedestrian hybrid beacons with high visibility crosswalks and median refuge islands.

Access to surrounding businesses and properties will be maintained at all times throughout construction. It is expected that one lane of traffic in each direction will also be maintained at all times. Specific information on the project's maintenance of traffic will be communicated to the public once finalized.

No streams, wetlands, jurisdictional ditches, ponds, lakes, reservoirs, retention/detention basins, or endangered species will be impacted.

Public involvement activities included providing education outreach materials for a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon with the City of East Cleveland to be distributed with the community. ODOT also held a virtual townhall meeting on June 9, 2020 during the study phase of the project. Comments received and addressed verbally during the virtual townhall are summarized in Meeting Minutes included in Project File/Public Involvement/Project Information/Public Involvement Summary.

The public, The City of East Cleveland's Police and Fire Department, and the East Cleveland City School District were also contacted via mail. Property Owner Notification Letters with a 30-day comment period were mailed to adjacent businesses and residences on November 29, 2021. Additional letters were sent on December 7, 2021 correcting the URL where the general public could leave comments. One comment was received and addressed via an individual response.

No other environmental, cultural resources, air, noise, hazardous materials, Section 4(f)/6(f), or underserved population impacts will result from this project.
