Project Description:

The City of Cleveland in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) propose improvements to Euclid Avenue (US-6) from Ivanhoe Road (East Cleveland Corp. line) to Upper Valley Drive in the city, Cuyahoga County. The work includes full depth milling & replacement of existing asphalt and installation of ADA compliant concrete sidewalks, curb ramps and pavement markings. At least one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times throughout construction. All work will be performed within the existing right-of-way.

The project is considered Ecologically Exempt under the Ecological MOA (Agreement 193340). See the Ecological tab for documentation.

A Regulated Materials Review Screening was conducted April 18, 2022. District 12 provided concurrence with no further investigations required on 4/20/2022. No deep excavation is required. See project file for documentation.

Based on the proposed scope of work, the project is exempt from National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and EO 11988 flood plain analysis.

The C1 approval is based on Stage 1 Plans.
