**Project Description:**

The Safe Routes to School project in the city of Bay Village will enhance the sidewalks and crossings at 5 intersections, Wolf Rd & Beach Ln, Osborn Rd & Sutcliffe Dr, Dover Center Rd & W. Oviatt Rd, Ashton Ln & Bassett Rd, and Bradley Rd & Bradley Park entrance drive. Each of these intersections are located along main routes that serve students walking and biking to one of the community school buildings. Proposed work includes adding high visibility signage, re-striping crosswalks and the replacement of curb ramps. All work will be conducted within the existing roadways and right-of-way. The Walk Audit and Infrastructure Countermeasure Maps are included in the Project File/General/Project Information/Project Study Area Map.PDF.

A Cultural Resource Records Check was performed by district environmental staff using the SHPO GIS online database. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within and/or immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties. No further coordination is required in accordance with the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. The Record Check can be found in the Project File under Cultural Resources/Project Information.

ODOT has reviewed the RMR Screening for CUY-SRT FY2023 Bay Village (PID 113826).Based upon a decision by the district, no further RMR is necessary for this project. See Project File/ESA/Coordination/District Decision No Further RMR.

Based on a consideration and ecological review, the project does not have the potential to impact ecological resources regulated under the under Sections 404 or 401 of the Clean Water Act, Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, or the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act, and should not result in any activities that violate ORC Chapters 1518 and 1531, or Section 1533.324. This project is considered Ecologically Exempt under the Ecological MOA (Agreement 19394).

The City of Bay Village along with Bay Village City Schools and the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Team engaged with the public regarding the proposed SRTS project in the following ways including staffing an information table with handouts at Bay Village Middle School, and Normandy and Westerly elementary schools open houses in August 2019; and presenting at both the Bay Village Board of Education meeting August 26, 2019, Bay Village Parent-Teacher Association meeting on September 5, 2019 and at City of Bay Village Council meeting September 3, 2019; and by holding 3 public input meetings to solicit comments from the general public. A summary of the meetings, including target audience, and key input received can be found in the Project File under Public Involvement/Project Information/Public Meeting Notification.PDF. For each of the meeting notices and during all presentations an electronic mailing address was provided for participants to utilize should they wish to comment on the project. A summary of the public comments can be found in the Project File under Public Involvement/Project Information/Public Comments Received.PDF.

The suggestions for updating the crossings on Dover Center and at the Osborne/Sutcliffe intersection were already a part of the SRTS plan. As such the City of Bay Village has decided to proceed with the project as proposed.

The C1 approval is based upon preliminary plans.
