Project Description:

The Lucas County is proposing to install a traffic signal at the intersection of King Rd and University Parks Trail to increase safety. Utility relocations are anticipated but there will no new right of way for this project. This project will have no impacts to any jurisdictional waterways so no USACE waterway permits are required. The project is not located within a floodplain so a floodplain permit is also not required. This project is located within the Oak Openings region and a plant survey for the listed plants that are known to be within 0.5 miles was completed on June 15th, 2022. None of the plants were found, therefore there will be no impacts to any listed species. There are no historic resources present within the project area there is minimal potential to have affects. Construction of this project will begin in the summer of 2023 and last approximately 45 days. During construction, traffic will be maintained at all times.
