Project Description:

The city of Tiffin, in coordination with ODOT, proposes to resurface State Route (SR) 18 (West Market Street) and SR 231 (South Washington Street). The project limits along SR 18 begin at Elmer Street and continue to SR 53 (South Sandusky Street). The project limits along SR 231 begin at County Road (CR) 19 (Sycamore Street) and continue to Glenn Street.

The project will include the following improvements:

- Planing and resurfacing; and
- Pavement restriping

This project will not require any additional right-of-way. The current estimated project cost, including construction, is \$726,000.00 with an anticipated aware date in March 2023.

The relocation of utilities will not be required for this project.

Construction is expected to begin in June 2023 and require up to 2.5 months to construct (August 15, 2023).

As a result of the proposed improvements, a detour route will not be required for vehicles or pedestrians. The contractor will maintain one lane two-way traffic at all times during construction via flagger on SR 231 and one lane one-way traffic at all times during construction on SR 18. There will be no road closures. SR 231 will be open to two-way traffic and both lanes of SR 18 will be open to one-way traffic during holidays and non-working hours. Access to properties located within the work zone will be maintained, including all businesses. Prior to construction, advanced notification will be provided to inform roadway users of the anticipated dates of construction.

No wetlands, streams, or endangered species habitat were found within the project area; therefore no impacts are anticipated to these resources and species.

No other environmental, cultural, or Section 4(f)/6(f) resources impacts will result from this project.

The public involvement activities during NEPA included initiation of maintenance of traffic discussions with public and emergency services, as well as property owners. Additionally, project notifications occurred for property owners and the general public, including a posting to the city of Tiffin's website (see Project File: Public Involvement/Property Owner Notification Letter.pdf, City Website Posting.pdf, and Maintenance of Traffic/Correspondence with Emergency and Public Services.pdf).

The environmental document and associated studies are being approved using Stage 1 Design. A copy of the plans is included in the project file.
