Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) county forces will be replacing the culvert under State Route 67 between US Route 224 and E. County Road 16 in Seneca County. The project is necessary to maintain drainage and road conditions. Permanent right of way is needed from 2 agricultural parcels and utilities will need to be relocated. This project is not located within a floodplain so no floodplain permit is required. A permit from the USACE is required for the work in a stream (approved permit in project file). Impacts to the stream and any listed species was coordinated with the appropriate resource agencies. The project has minimal potential to cause adverse effects since there were no historically significant resources in the area. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2023 and last approximately 30 days. The work will require a temporary closure of State Route 67 for approximately 30 days. During the closure, all access to properties will be maintained. Property owners, public safety agencies, and the local schools were notified of the road closure.

This document was written and approved based on stage 3 plans.

This project is not currently on the STP, however the next phase is non-federal 100% state funded and is fiscally constrained.
