Project Description:

The Cuyahoga County Engineer in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) propose rehabilitation of 1.3 miles of East 200th (CR-114) from Mohican Avenue to Lakeshore Blvd (SR-283) in the City of Euclid in Cuyahoga County. The work includes resurfacing of the roadway, performing pavement repairs as required based on condition, replacement of pavement markings, and installation of ADA compliant curb ramps. The project also includes installation of approximately 7,600 feet of water main. All work will be performed withing the existing right-of-way.

The project is considered Ecologically Exempt under the Ecological MOA (Agreement 19394). See the Ecological tab for documentation. There is no work in streams, wetlands, or pollinator initiative sites. No tree removal.

The project is not located within a regulated floodplain; therefore, no coordination is required.

Regulated Materials Review Screening was conducted June 21, 2023, ODOT District 12 has determined that Regulated Material (RM) plan notes are required to address possible soil contamination, and they provided concurrence on July 14, 2023 with no further RMR investigations is required.

The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study area.

The public was notified via a news release published in Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works website on May 16, 2023, soliciting for comments. The public comment period closed on June 23,2023. The received comments were generally in the favor of the project. The responses to the received comments are coordinated through the County. All the received comments and the County feedback are included in public comments tracker sheet in the Project File. All public involvement materials and documents have been uploaded to the Project File tab under Public Involvement.

Based on public comments, the County has made the determination to proceed with the project as currently designed.

The environmental review and associated studies are being approved based on Stage 3 design. Plans are included in Project File/General/Project Information/Stage 3 Design.pdf
