**Project Description:**

The City of Brecksville in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to resurface Brecksville Road (SR 21) from the southern edge of the Miller Road intersection to the southern City corporation limit with the Village of Richfield. The project includes curb to curb resurfacing, limited base and curb repair. The project also includes sidewalks on both sides of the road for the entire length of the resurfacing which will require driveway apron replacements. The estimated length of project is 0.82-miles. ADA compliant curb ramps will be installed as necessary throughout the project length.

Traffic will be maintained during construction.

Work will occur within the existing R/W.

There will be no tree or shrub removal for this project, but some trimming of limbs for vertical clearance may be required.

This project will not have any adverse impacts to cultural resources and ecological resources.

There are no hazardous materials within the site and no activities such as deep excavation will be taking place.

There will be no in-water work, or work within wetlands, or pollinator initiative areas.

The Stage 2 construction cost estimate is \$ 2,700,000.

\$1,080,000 is federal funding (90%, but capped at \$1,080,000)

The amount exceeding (\$1,620,000) is the responsibility of the City of Brecksville

Public Involvement was completed during the project's development with a notification posted to the City's website on September 13, 2023 that provided a description of the work, schedule, cost and contact information for comments and questions. No comments were received during the 30 day comment period.

Public Involvement Conclusion: No revisions to the design were made due to public comment as no comments were received. The City will proceed with the project as currently designed.

## Environmental Commitments

### C1

1) Environmental Commitments to be included in the plans are as follows:

1. No trees and shrubs will be removed for this project
- 2) 2. No in-water work will be conducted.
- 3) 3. All areas within the limits of pavement construction and all areas disturbed by the contractor shall be re-vegetated per ODOT Item 659.
- 4) 4. Seed Mix shall be Class 1 - lawn mixture applied at double seed rate specified in 659.09.
- 5) 5. All stones 1" in diameter or larger and construction aggregate or debris shall be removed from the planting bed area prior to placing top soil.
- 6) 6. The contractor shall furnish and place clean, sifted topsoil per ODOT Item 653 to a minimum of 4" in lawn areas and 2" on sloped areas 4:1 or steeper.
- 7) 7. The contractor is required to establish a minimum density of 80% grass cover of uniform color and density to the satisfaction of the engineer.
