Rehabilitation of deteriorated asphalt roadway (1 mile total: 0.45 miles in Brookside Reservation and 0.55 miles in West Creek Reservation) and parking lots (21,000 sy)

All work is within existing Metroparks property.

No deep excavation is required.

Construction Cost Estimate: \$675,000.00 80% State and 20% local funding.
