Project Description:

Repair or reconstruct 5 ramps along IR-480 at Grayton Road, West 150th, and West 139th in the Cities of Cleveland and Brook Park..

All work within existing ROW.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by district environmental staff Corey Czinger, Environmental Specialist 3, using the online OSHPO ArcMap Resource Map. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within and/or immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties in accordance with Minimal Potential to Cause Effect - Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. No further coordination is required. District approval date 04/03/26.

This C1-level repair or reconstruct 5 ramps project has such a remote chance of affecting base food elevation that it is excluded from analysis.

No ROW or deep excavation greater than six (6) feet required. Project is not within 300 feet of a landfill. Regulated Materials Review Form district approval date 03/11/26. The Regulated Materials Review Form can be found in the Project File Under RMR/Report.

No work in streams, wetlands, or pollinator initiative sites. No tree removal.

Construction: \$3,424,000.00: 90% federal and 10% state.
