Project Description:

The Seneca County Engineers Office is proposing to paint new pavement marking on various county roads throughout Seneca County. All work is within the existing right of way and no utilities will be impacted. There will be no impacts to any jurisdictional waterways so no permits from the USACE or OEPA are required. Several locations are within a special flood hazard area, however no floodplain permits are required. Pavement marking projects are exempt from USFWS coordination due to the mobile and non-disruptive nature of the work. There will be no impacts to any ecological or historically significant resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2024 and last approximately 60 days. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.

The environmental document and associated studies are being approved using Stage 3 Design. A copy of the plans are included in the project file.
