Project Description:

The City of Maple Heights in cooperation with the Cuyahoga County Engineer's Office (Sponsoring Agency) and Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to rehabilitate Rockside Road from East 140th Street to the western limit of the approach slab of the bridge over Norfolk Southern. The project includes curb to curb resurfacing, limited full and partial-depth pavement repairs, walk and drive apron repairs, as needed for the installation of ADA-compliant curb ramps as well as minimal sidewalk work outside the limits of curb ramps. The estimated length of project is 1.36-miles.

The project will be constructed part-width and traffic will be maintained - one lane in each direction.

Work will occur within the existing R/W.

Two (2) OHI sites were identified within the project limits at the Rockside Road/Dunham Road intersection. Reference Documents located in Project Filt/Cultural Resources/Project Information names Records Check.pdf and Records Check.xls depict the sites. CUY000324 - Little Red School House (currently the Maple Heights Historical Society and Museum at 5810 Dunham Road, which is the southwest corner of the intersection) and CUY-160324 - Zion Lutheran Church (currently the Abundant Grace Fellowship church at 5780 Dunham Road, which is the northwest corner of the intersection). The project will not have any impacts to these properties/resources.

This project will not have any adverse impacts to ecological resources.

There are no hazardous materials within the site and no activities such as deep excavation will be taking place.

There will be no in-water work, or work within wetlands, or pollinator initiative areas.

The Stage 1 construction cost estimate is \$2,719,000.

Federal funding (NOACA STBG) will be utilized to pay for 80% of the construction cost, with a \$2,177,777.60 maximum. Costs in excess of this amount are the responsibility of the City/County.

Public Involvement was completed during the project's development with a notification posted to the Cuyahoga County and Public Works websites on February 29, 2024 that provided a description of the work and contact information for comments and questions. Additionally, the notice was posted on Maple Heights website for more exposure. Two inquiries were made related to the project - one from Cleveland Water Department related to schedule so that they can perform water work in advance and one from a resident asking about driveway access. Both inquiries were answered. No comments specific to the project scope were received during the 30 day comment period.

Public Involvement Conclusion: No revisions to the design were made due to public comment as no comments related to the scope of work were received. The City and County will proceed with the project as currently designed.

The C1 approval is based upon the Stage 1 plans which are included on the Project File tab under General/Project Information
