Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation District 2 is proposing a project to install recessed wet reflective pavement markings on various routes throughout the district. Necessary related work will also be performed. All work is within the existing right of way and there will be no impact to utilities. This project does not include impacts to any waterways or floodplains, therefore no US Army Corps of Engineers or floodplain permits are required. This project is located within a special flood hazard area. It was determined by the district 2 hydraulic engineer that there would be no impacts to the floodplain. There will be no impacts to any ecological or historically significant resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2025 and last approximately 120 days. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.
