Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing to resurface an old weigh station located on I-75 North in Wood County and turn it into a truck parking facility. There is no work outside of the existing right of way and there will be no impacts to any utilities. This facility is not located in any flood hazard areas and there are no jurisdictional resources in the project area so no permits will be required. This will have minimal impacts to any significant historical or ecological resources. Construction is expected to begin in summer 2025 and last approximately 60 days. There will be no traffic disruptions due to this project.
