Resurface Auburn Road (CR-4) from Chardon Road (US-6) to the Lake County Line (Colburn Rd/Auburn Rd) in Chardon Township in Geauga County.

All work within existing r/w.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by District 12 staff using the SHPO ArcGIS online database. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within the proposed project area.
