Project Description:

The City of Toledo is currently proposing to reconstruct the pavement on Arlington Avenue from Detroit Avenue to Spencer Street in Lucas County. Work includes new curbs, drive aprons, some sidewalk replacement, pedestrian bump-outs within some parking areas, and other necessary related work items. Temporary right of way is required to adjust drive slopes from two commercial housing properties.

Since there is no work within any waters of the US and there are no floodplain impacts, no permits are required. There are some ecological species located within 1 mile of the project sites, but there will be no impacts to any state or federally listed species or their habitat. This project has a minimal potential to cause impacts to any historical resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2026 and last approximately 60 days. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2026 and last approximately 180 days. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained.
