**Project Description:**

The Cities of South Euclid and University Heights in cooperation with the Cuyahoga County Engineer's Office (Sponsoring Agency) and Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to rehabilitate Warrensville Center Road from Fairmount Boulevard to the southern edge of the Mayfield Road intersection. The southbound lanes of the road (Mayfield to Bayard) in Cleveland Heights have been previously improved and are excluded from this project. The project includes curb to curb resurfacing, limited full and partial-depth pavement repairs, walk and drive apron repairs, as needed for the installation of ADA-compliant curb ramps as well as minimal sidewalk work outside the limits of curb ramps. Pedestrian hybrid beacons will be constructed at Hillbrook Road and Traymore Road and decorative concrete crosswalks installed in the Cedar Road intersection. The estimated length of project is 2.3-miles.

The project will be constructed part-width and traffic will be maintained - one lane in each direction.

Work will occur within the existing R/W.

One (1) OHI site was identified adjacent to the project limits at 1643 Warrensville Center Road (aka Ernest Hugu House). Reference Documents located in Project File/Cultural Resources/Project Information names Records Check.pdf and Records Check.xls depict the site. CUY0193522 - Ernest Hugu House is located on the east side of the road, south of the intersection with Corwin Road. The University Heights Fire Department Exhaust Extraction System at 3980 Silsby Road has a SHPO Determination of Eligibility. The University Heights Fire Department Exhaust Extraction System is located adjacent to the project limits on the west side of Warrensville Center Rd, south of the intersection with Silsby Rd. The project will not have any impact to these properties/resources.

This project will not have any adverse impacts to ecological resources.

There are no hazardous materials within the site and no activities such as deep excavation will be taking place.

There will be no in-water work, or work within wetlands, or pollinator initiative areas, no tree removal.

The Stage 1/2 construction cost estimate is \$7, 506,000

Federal funding (NOACA STBG) will be utilized to pay for 80% of the construction cost with a \$5,838,202 maximum. TLCI/STBG funds in the amount of \$251,000 will be applied to construction, at 100%, with no match. Costs in excess of this amount are the responsibility of the City/County.

Public Involvement was completed during the project's development with a notification posted to the Cuyahoga County website on February 14, 2025 that provided a description of the work and contact information for comments and questions. No comments were received or inquiries were answered. No comments specific to the project scope were received during the 30 day comment period.

Public Involvement Conclusion: No revisions to the design were made due to public comment as no comments related to the scope of work were received. The Cities and County will proceed with the project as currently designed.
