Project Description:

The project will include a mill and overlay of Bagley Road from 200' east of Lindberg Street east to Beech Street, a length of approximately 1 mile. Where warranted, full depth pavement replacement will occur. The project will also include mill and overlay of side streets near their intersection with Bagley Road. The project will assess curb ramps throughout the entire project corridor. It is anticipated that all curb ramps will be replaced. Lastly, expansion joints will be resealed at the bridge over the East Branch Rocky River. No work will occur on the bridge. All work will within existing r/w.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by Austin Clarridge of CMT, using the online OSHPO ArcMap Resource Map. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within the proposed project area. The Baldwin-Wallace College North Campus Historic District is adjacent to the project area but will not be impacted by this resurfacing project. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties in accordance with Minimal Potential to Cause Effect - Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. No further coordination is required. The Records Check can be found in the Project File Under Cultural Resources/Project Information. District Approval date: 7/9/2025.

The project crosses the mapped floodplain of East Branch Rocky River; however, this C1-level resurfacing project has such a remote chance of affecting base food elevation that it is excluded from analysis.

No deep excavation will occur as part of the project.

No work in streams, wetlands, or pollinator initiative sites. No tree removal.

A press release was published on the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works website on May 7, 2025 and included a 30-day public comment period. Stakeholder Involvement letters were sent on May 5, 2025 and included a 30-day comment period.

Copies of the press release and stakeholder letter are uploaded in the EnviroNet Project File under Public Involvement/Project Information. No comments were received during the public comment period. The project will proceed with the project as designed.

Construction costs for the project are \$5,115,000.00 (80% federal and 20% local).
