Project Description:

Feasibility Study of the Detroit-Superior Bridge (SFN 1800930) over the Cuyahoga River in the city of Cleveland. Study will investigate current conditions, perform a comprehensive load rating of all structural units and explore rehabilitation options versus long term cycle costs and serviceability.

All work within existing ROW.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by district environmental staff Corey Czinger, Environmental Specialist 3, using the online OSHPO ArcMap Resource Map. Cultural Resources are listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within and immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. Detroit-Superior Bridge (SFN 1800930) is a historic bridge (1800930). The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties. No further coordination is required in accordance with ORC 149.53 Appendix A. The Record Check can be found in the Project File Under Cultural Resources/Project Information. This project is located in a floodplain Zone AE; however, this is feasibility study. This C1-level feasibility study project has such a remote chance of affecting base food elevation that it is excluded from analysis. The FEMA Firm can be found in the Project File Under Permits/Floodplains.
