Project Description:

Reconstruct, via a 3 inch planning and resurfacing, of Southgate Park Blvd from Warrensville Center Rd to Northfield Rd with to stripe a lane in each direction with a two-way left-turn lane in the center for motor vehicles and bike lanes along each curb in the City of Maple Heights in Cuyahoga County. Includes 2 mid-block RRFB crossings, bike racks, signage and pavement markings including upgraded crosswalks, curbs/curb ramps, and sidewalk repairs where necessary. The estimated project length is 0.57 miles.

All work within existing ROW.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by district environmental staff Corey Czinger, Environmental Specialist 3, using the online OSHPO ArcMap Resource Map. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within the proposed project area. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties in accordance with Minimal Potential to Cause Effect - Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. No further coordination is required. The Records Check can be found in the Project File Under Cultural Resources/Project Information. District approval date 05/05/25.

This project is not located in a floodplain. This C1-level reconstruction Southgate Park Blvd, with work as stated above, has such a remote chance of affecting base food elevation that it is excluded from analysis.

No ROW or deep excavation greater than six (6) feet required. Project is not within 300 feet of a landfill. Regulated Materials Review Form district approval date 05/05/25. The Regulated Materials Review Form can be found in the Project File Under RMR/Report.

No work in streams, wetlands, or pollinator initiative sites. No tree removal.

Construction: \$1,461,682.20: 80% federal and 20% local.

The project has been designed by Chagrin Valley Engineering.

Public involvement was completed during project development with a notification posted to the City's website on May 2, 2025 that provided a description of the work and contact information for comments and questions. No comments were received/or inquiries were answered specific to the project scope during the 30 day comment period.

Public Involvement Conclusion: Revisions (no) to the design were made due to public comments as not comments resulted in a change to the project scope. The City will proceed with the project as currently designed.
