Project Description:

Resurface US-422 from the Cuyahoga River to the Parkman Township line in Troy Township, Geauga County.

All work within existing ROW.

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by district environmental staff Corey Czinger, Environmental Specialist 3, using the online OSHPO ArcMap Resource Map. Two (2) Historic Surveys (H00127 and H00126) were within the project area. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within and/or immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties in accordance with Minimal Potential to Cause Effect - Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. No further coordination is required. District approval date 07/01/26.

This C1-level resurfacing project has such a remote chance of affecting base flood elevation that it is excluded from analysis.

No ROW or deep excavation greater than six (6) feet required. Project is not within 300 feet of a landfill. Regulated Materials Review Form district approval date 07/01/26. The Regulated Materials Review Form can be found in the Project File Under RMR/Report.

No work in streams, wetlands, or pollinator initiative sites. No tree removal.

Construction: \$2,120,000.00: 80% federal and 20% state.
