Project Description:

The Wood County Engineers Office is proposing to replace the superstructure of the bridge on Cygnet Road between Cloverdale Rd and Huffman Rd. Temporary right of way will be required for this project and there may be temporary impacts to any utilities. The bridge work will not require a waterway permit from the USACE or a floodplain permit since there will be no work in the stream. There are no impacts to any listed species or their habitat. This project has minimal potential to cause adverse effects to any historically significant resources. Construction is expected to begin in the fall of 2027. During construction, a temporary road closure of 60 days required for the bridge work. All impacted public safety agencies and schools have been notified of the upcoming road closure.
