Project Description:

The ODOT Wood County Garage will be replacing a catch basin and outlet under State Route 105 between Luckey Rd and Kohring Rd.

All work is within the existing right of way, and there will be no impact to utilities. Since there is no work within any waters of the US, no permits are required. The project is located within a floodplain and all coordination has been completed. There are some ecological species located within 1 mile of the project sites, but there will be no impacts to any state or federally listed species or their habitat. This project has a minimal potential to cause impacts to any historical resources. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2026 and last approximately 14 days. During construction, State Route 105 will be closed for the duration of the work.

1) Ensure impacts to the federally listed and protected Indiana bat and northern long-eared bat are avoided and minimized. Do not remove trees from April 1 through September 30. Perform all necessary tree removal from October 1 through March 31. Demarcate clearing limits in the field to avoid any unauthorized tree clearing. For the purposes of this note, a tree is defined as a live, dying, or dead woody plant, with a trunk three inches or greater in diameter at a height of 4.5 feet above the ground surface, and with a minimum height of 13 feet.
