Pavement marking contract for various location throughout D-12.

 - The temporary road, detour or ramp closure does not substantially change the environmental consequences of the action
 - There is no substantial controversy associated with the temporary road, detour, or ramp closure
- Any known regulated materials sites, or previous land uses with potential for hazardous materials within the right-of-way including:
 - A landfill, dump, and/or solid waste facility within 300 feet of the project unless it is an activity exempt from Rule 513
 - Project does not require deep excavation six feet or greater in depth (Signal/utility pole installation will not be considered as having deep excavation).
- The action will not impact suitable habitat for a state or federally listed endangered or threatened species within the occupied range or critical habitat for the species
