Project Description:

The city of Girard proposes landscaping enhancements adjacent to the westbound Interstate Route (IR) 80 exit ramp to U.S. Route (USR) 422 in the city of Girard, Trumbull County, Ohio. The project proposes to construct new gateway signage, install new landscape features (i.e., shrubs, flowers, mulch, flag pole, etc.) and install a minor amount of sidewalk.

Street/ramp closures, detours, lane restrictions or other maintenance of traffic measures will not be necessary to construct the project. Therefore, no substantial traffic disruptions are anticipated with the project.

Based on the project scope of work, its Path 1 Preliminary Development Process (PDP) Classification and the lack of maintenance of traffic measures, emergency/public services contact activities were not conducted for the project.

The project will be constructed within the existing IR 80 limited access right-of-way.

Existing utilities within the project study area will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

Based on the proposed scope of work, the project has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties under Appendix A. The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study area.

The environmental document and associated studies, as applicable, were approved using the preliminary scope of work for the project. When available, the project plans will be reviewed by ODOT District 4 Environmental Section personnel and uploaded to the Project File/General/Project Information subsection as Stage 3 Design.pdf.
