Project Description:

The Stark County Engineer proposes to re-apply pavement markings on various routes throughout Stark County, Ohio.

During project construction, a minimum of one (1) 10-foot lane of traffic shall be maintained in each direction on existing pavements. No substantial traffic disruptions are anticipated with the project.

The project will be constructed within the existing roadway rights-of-way.

Based on the proposed scope of work, the project has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties under Appendix A. The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study areas.

Based on the project scope of work, its Path 1 Preliminary Development Process (PDP) Classification and the proposed maintenance of traffic measures, emergency/public services contact activities were not conducted for the project.

Existing utilities within the project study areas will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

The environmental document and associated studies, as applicable, were approved using the preliminary scope of work for the project.
