Project Description:

This project proposes to seal the parapets of several bridges along the I-75 corridor in Lucas County. Vandal fencing will also be installed on some of the bridges. All work is within the existing right of way and no utilities will be impacted. There will be no work below the deck of any bridge so no waterway permits are required. Several bridges are located within or above a special flood hazard area but there will be no impacts to the floodplain. There will be no ecological impacts as stated in the "Ecological Review Form" in the project file. This project is covered under Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement for State Funded Projects (Agreement No. 19319), which are undertakings with minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2019 and last approximately. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access on or under the bridges will be maintained at all times.

- 1) Notes shall be placed in the plans by ODOT directing the contractor to comply with the notification requirement timeframes outlined in the Traffic Engineering Manual Part 642-8 and 642-58 to ensure compliance with Federal notification requirements.
- 2) The contractor shall take all precautions to prevent any and all material from going off the edge of bridge deck(s) and edge of culvert(s) during all construction operations. The contractor shall immediately remove any material that falls into the roadside ditches, streams, wetlands, or other waters through non-mechanical means. Under no circumstances shall the contractor work in or store equipment and/or materials in any wetlands, streams, or other waters. No work or staging is permitted below the top of bank of any stream and/or within a wetland.
- 3) Vehicular and pedestrian access on or under the following bridges shall be maintained at all times: a. LUC-75-0301 (Oakwood Ave. over I-75) b LUC-75-0520 L, C & R (I-75 over Willys Parkway) c. LUC-75-0524 (Willys Parkway over Ottawa River) d. LUC-75-0577 L&R (I-75 over Berdan Ave. & Detroit Ave.) e. LUC-75-0631 (I-75 over Phillips Ave.) f. LUC-75-0670 (I-75 over Lagrange St.) g. LUC-75-0762 (I-75 over Stickney Ave.)
- 4) The contractor shall perform all work within the existing right of way.
