Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to replace existing deteriorated highway signs along Interstate Route (IR) 77 from the Stark/Tuscarawas County Line (Straight Line Mile [SLM] 0.00) to the IR 77/U. S. Route 30 Interchange (SLM 9.3) and along U. S. Route 30 from the U. S. Route 30/State Route 43 (Belden Avenue) Interchange (SLM 16.86) to the U. S. Route 30/Trump Avenue Interchange (SLM 18.80) in the city of Canton and Canton, Pike and Bethlehem Townships, Stark County, Ohio. This project will remove the existing overhead/structure mounted/post mounted signs and install new signs on existing sign supports. Existing damaged sign supports will also be repaired or replaced by the project.

Mapping that depicts the project study areas on United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-Minute Topographic Quadrangle Maps is included in the Project File/General/Project Information subsection as USGS Quadrangle Topographic Map.pdf.

Intermittent, short duration lane and/or shoulder closures may occur on IR 77 and U. S. Route 30 during highway sign replacement activities. Lane and/or shoulder closures shall only be established during non-peak traffic periods. Construction and lane restriction information will be posted prior to the start of construction. Substantial traffic disruptions are not anticipated with the project.

The project will be constructed within the existing highway rights-of-way.

Existing utilities within the project study areas will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

The project is exempt from further evaluation for regulated materials. See Project File ESA/Reports/Regulated Materials Review Form.pdf.

The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study area.
