Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes systematic sign replacement along various sections of Interstate Routes (IR) 76, 77 and 271 in Summit County, as follows:

- IR 76/Kenmore section between straight line mile (SLM) 6.90 and SLM 8.24 in the city of Akron;
- IR 77 between SLM 0.00 and SLM 6.00 in the city of Green and between SLM 24.00 and SLM 25.00 in Bath Township; and
- IR 271 between SLM 0.00 and SLM 11.45 in the city of Macedonia, the village of Richfield and Bath, Boston, Northfield Center, Richfield Townships.

The project will be constructed within the existing highway rights-of-way.

A minimum of one (1) 12-foot lane in each direction shall be maintained on the existing pavement during sign replacement. Substantial traffic disruptions are not expected with the project.

Existing utilities within the project study areas will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

Based on the project scope of work, its Path 1 Preliminary Development Process (PDP) Classification and the proposed maintenance of traffic measures, emergency/public services contact activities were not conducted for the project.

Based on the information contained in the RMR Form prepared for the project, further environmental site assessment or special materials management is not warranted for the project. See the RMR Form for the project in the Project File/ESA/Reports subsection.
