Project Description:

The City of Cleveland proposes to rehabilitate Clark Avenue pavement between West 41st Street and Quigley Road in the City of Cleveland. The work includes adding bike lanes, full depth pavement repair, partial depth pavement repair, resurface with asphalt concrete, new curbs, underdrain, catch basins, driveways, sidewalk replacement, waterline replacement, traffic signal work, and new signs and pavement markings.

This is funded by federal (80%) and Local (20%) funds.

No new right-of-way is required. No waterway permits are required.

Two stakeholder meetings were held with the City of Cleveland and several neighborhood group representatives. A public meeting was held on April 25, 2018. Twenty-nine people attended the meeting. Five written comments were received primary concerns were parking, public art, bike racks, bus shelters, and use of pavers. All environmental work was conducted from the public right-of-way, so no Property owner letters were not sent.

ESA investigations resulted in the inclusion of a petroleum contaminated soils (PCS) plan note. No other environmental, ecological, historic, or environmental justice impacts will result from this project.
