Project Description:

The Village of North Baltimore is proposing to reconstruct the pavement on N. Main Street. Additional work includes new sidewalk, drainage, signals, and decorative lighting. These repairs will not require right of way and will not impact utilities. There will be no impacts to any waterways so no permits from the US Army Corps of Engineers is required. This project does not pass through several floodplains so no development permit is required. There will be no impacts to any ecologically significant resources. Since there is no work outside of the right of way and there are no historic districts near this project, there is minimal potential to cause effects on historical resources. Construction is expected to begin in spring of 2020 and last approximately 90 days total. During construction, a minimum of one lane will be maintained at all times.
