Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing to upgrade and maintain the traffic signals at 2 intersections (State Route 2 at Holloway Rd and State Route 184 at Whiteford) in Lucas County. Temporary right of way is required from 1 vacant commercial property for access to a signal. Utility impacts are anticipated. Since there are no impacts to any waterways, a permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers is not required. Neither of the project locations are within a floodplain. There will be no impacts to any ecologically significant resources and there is minimal potential to cause impacts to any historic sites. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2019 and last approximately 30 days. During construction, all pedestrian and vehicular traffic will be maintained.
