Paint the structural steel on multiple mainline bridges along the SR-2 corridor: SR-283, Sanford Road , St. Clair Road, State Street, Grand River, and Bacon Road.

Funding:

Preliminary engineering: 100% state

Construction Cost Estimate: \$4,300,000. 100% state funding

The project will not require additional right-of-way.

A Level 1 Ecological Survey Report was prepared and no waterway or other ecological resources will be impacted. OES determined 'This is a 100% state funded project with no need for a waterway permit. As proposed this project has no federal nexus or need for Section 7 consultation. Environmental commitments will be made to avoid impacting nesting birds and for a containment system used to ensure that no contamination reaches the stream. Effect calls for listed species have been made based on these environmental commitments. No further ecological coordination is required.' See the 9/9/21 OES Decision document in the Project File.

1) Add the following plan note to the project plans:

Ecological studies identified swallow nests on the LAK-2-16.56 L & R Bridges over the Grand River. Projects performing construction activities between the dates of September 1 and April 30 do not require an inspection for migratory birds or avoidance measures. If construction activities will occur between May 1 and August 31 on this structure, inspect the structure for evidence of an active bird nest containing an egg or chick prior to starting work. Provide written confirmation of the inspection, including a statement whether an active nest was found, to the Engineer. If no nests are encountered during the inspection, or if only inactive nests that do not contain an egg or chick are encountered, proceed with construction activities. The Contractor may remove and destroy inactive nests. If an active nest containing an egg or chick is encountered, avoid impacts to the nest until all developing birds are able to independently fly from the nest.

2) No work can take place below the Ordinary Highwater Mark (OHWM) of the Grand River. No barges or equipment can be used in the Grand River due to the presence of federally endangered mussels. Small boat can used in the Grand River

3) A containment system must be installed around the LAK-2-16.56 L&R bridges to prevent contamination into the Grand River.
